Dear Eric,

I hope that you are well. Our Bermuda Project is chugging along, and I am writing for permission to quote (in our scholarly publications) one of the documents you provided us as a supplement to your interview.

The document in question is the Programme and Participants List for the 1998 Bermuda meeting. You indicated on your archiving form that you would like us to wait ten years after the date of your interview to release your interview transcript and its supplemental materials to the general public on our website. The Programme/ Participants List is one of these supplemental materials, and since you indicated an embargo, it is our belief that we should ask your permission to quote directly from the materials in our scholarly publications.

It turns out that the Programme is the one of the most reliable sources we've found for the names of the Bermuda delegates in 1998. There is the *Genome Research* piece from Mark Guyer in 1998, but there are some discrepancies between Guyer's list and the one that was in your files. Thus we'd like to be able to use both in our publications. Similarly, we have not found any other documentation of the 1998 Programme, which contains a meeting agenda. We would also like to reproduce this agenda in our papers.

Please note that the Programme and Participants List were provided to us in a single booklet. In that booklet, you also took several pages of handwritten notes. We are not asking for permission at this time to quote directly from the notes, though we may in the future. Right now, we are just asking for permission to reproduce your copy of the agenda and delegates list from Bermuda 1998.
